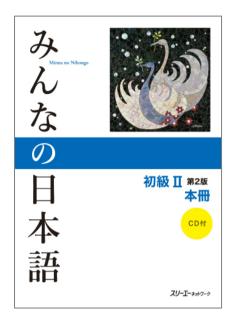


# Daily Conversation: Upper Beginner (Level 5-8)

Textbook: みんなの日本語 初級 II



# Level 5 (16 lessons)

# [Goal]

- 1. Have a natural conversation using spoken language
- 2. Explain a troubling situation and make a request or apology
- 3. Think about what needs to be prepared and explain it

# Lesson 1:

- Make sentences with "∼nndesu"
- Use "∼nndesuka?" and make confirmations
- Ask for an explanation of the information you want

# Lesson 2:

- Ask reasons by using "∼nndesuka?" and/or make response to that kind of questions
- Ask for advice using preface remarks
- Make requests using preface remarks

# Lesson 3:

- Learn how to make potential verbs
- Talk about your own abilities and ask about others' abilities
- Ask what is possible at facilities, etc.



#### Lesson 4:

- Understand when to use "miraremasu/kikemasu" and "miemasu/kikoemasu"
- Give information about facilities and stores in the street

# Lesson 5:

- Talk about two habits you're doing at the same time
- Talk about something you do habitually
- Introduce good things about your friends and family

# Lesson 6:

- Explain things by giving two or more reasons
- Introduce a favorite restaurant or store with reasons
- Decline an invitation by giving reasons

# Lesson 7:

- Understand differences between intransitive and transitive verbs
- Describe your surroundings using intransitive verbs
- Use different words for "broken" depending on the object

# Lesson 8:

- Explain a troubling situation
- Express regret and/or disappointment
- Tell others what has been done/will be done

# Lesson 9:

- Describe situations where something has already been done
- Talk and listen to what preparations need to be made before a trip or meeting

# Lesson 10:

- Tell others what to do or ask what to do for the next time you use something
- Tell others to leave something as it is

# Lesson 11:

- Have a natural conversation using "∼nndesu"
- Use "∼te imasu / ∼te arimasu" and "∼te shimaimashita / ∼te okimasu" where appropriate



#### Lesson 12:

- Learn how to make volitional forms of verbs
- Invite people using casual expression
- Talk about what you are planning to do on holidays, etc.

# Lesson 13:

- Talk about my future plans
- Tell your schedule in business scenes
- Talk about your goals and dreams for the future

# Lesson 14:

- Explain symptoms of your illness or injury.
- Give advice on "what to do" and "what not to do"

# Lesson 15:

- Make assumptions on the situation of the world and your country in the future.
- Imagine and talk about what you will be like in five or ten years

# Lesson 16:

- Have natural conversations using spoken language
- Explain the situation you're placed in and make requests and apologies

# Level 6 (16 lessons)

# [Goal]

- 1. Talk about your goals and plans for the future
- 2. Explain in simple terms how to do things and in what order
- 3. Ask for/give advice on a variety of topics and matters

# Lesson 1:

- Understand imperative and prohibitive forms
- Cheer at a sports game, etc.
- Strongly warn people about what must NOT be done

# Lesson 2:

- Ask how to read a kanji which you don't know
- Be taught about meanings of words you don't know
- Politely ask to deliver a message to a certain person on the phone



#### Lesson 3:

- Show someone the procedure of something, understand things you've been taught from others
- Listen to directions and explanations and act accordingly

# Lesson 4:

- Tell people what to do later (not now)
- Explain how to use things and cook food in order

# Lesson 5:

- Learn how to make conditional forms of verbs
- Explain what changes depending on conditions
- Explain how nature changes according to seasons

# Lesson 6:

- Explain a situation and ask for advice
- Respond in response to a request for your advice

# Lesson 7:

- Organize and understand "~to" "~tara" "~ba/nara"
- Learn how to use verb forms learned up to L.35

#### Lesson 8:

- Speak using the correct verb forms according to grammatical expressions
- Use appropriate particles

# Lesson 9:

- Talk about what you try to do to avoid problems
- Compare/contrast the past with the present and talk about what you've become able to do now

# Lesson 10:

- Talk about the changes in customs and life in the world
- Tell what you are continuously working on to achieve your goals

# Lesson 11:

- Explain rules and understand rules
- Teach people what needs to be done with caution in your country



#### Lesson 12:

- Learn how to make passive forms of verbs
- Talk about compliments and requests you received
- Express how you got puzzled from what you received from others

# Lesson 13:

- Introduce famous buildings in my country
- Talk about events
- Understand ingredients of food and things

# Lesson 14:

- Understand the words used in "~noga/nowo/noha" and incorporate them into conversation
- Talk about your favorite actions

# Lesson 15:

- Deliver the points you want to convey more strongly to others
- Present more new information in conversation

# Lesson 16:

- Talk about your goals and plans for the future
- Explain the procedure of things in simple terms
- Ask for and give advice

# Level 7 (16 lessons)

# [Goal]

- 1. Talk about what you're doing and what you've been able to do in relation to your goals
- 2. Share information with each other about what you don't know or what you are worried about
- 3. Politely express gratitude for what others have done for you

# Lesson 1:

- Explain a situation and express your feelings
- Explain a situation and refuse an invitation
- Understand causes of accidents and disasters



#### Lesson 2:

- Make a polite request with reasons
- Politely state reason and ask for permission
- Explain a situation with polite reasons

# Lesson 3:

- Learn cause and reason expressions such as "~te · de", "~node · kara"
- How to use particle "∼de"
- Learn various ways of counting, depending on the subject

# Lesson 4:

- Understand a natural way of asking questions by asking indirectly what you want to know
- Understand words where adjectives turn into nouns and use them

# Lesson 5:

- Check A or B or current situation
- Talk about what you want to challenge
- Try on clothes, shoes, etc. at a store

# Lesson 6:

- Have conversations using the correct verb form according to grammatical expressions
- Use appropriate grammatical expressions according to the context

# Lesson 7:

- Politely express an event where you received a gift from someone
- Talk about how you take care of the pets you have or the plants you grow

#### Lesson 8:

- Talk to others about people who you have been taken care of or helped before
- Express gratitude to the people who have helped you before
- Make a request to someone in a very polite way

# Lesson 9:

- Talk about what you're currently doing to achieve your goals
- Describe what you are doing to achieve your goals
- Talk about your purpose of coming to Japan



#### Lesson 10:

- Explain how to use the things around you
- Evaluate objects, places, and things
- Explain cost and time involved

# Lesson 11:

- Use "~tameni" "~youni" where appropriate
- Read sentences and expand on the topic to have a conversation

# Lesson 12:

- Explain the situation in front of you in simple terms
- Talk to others in an appropriate manner based on their conditions
- Talk to others while taking in consideration of them

# Lesson 13:

- Predict and talk about the weather and what is likely to happen in the future
- Talk about the current status of family and friends
- Talk about the purpose of going out

# Lesson 14:

- Indicates that the extent of an action or state is excessive
- Explain why you're not feeling well
- Communicate with clerks at clothing and shoe stores about sizes

# Lesson 15:

- Talk about the state and conditions of the things and places you usually use
- Make requests to change quantities or conditions
- Choose and decide on a menu or schedule

# Lesson 16:

- Talk about what you're doing to reach your goals, and whether you're becoming good at it or not
- Share information about what you don't know and what you're worried about



# Level 8 (16 lessons)

# [Goal]

- 1. Exchange information with others based on the current situation
- 2. Explain the situation you are placed in and show thoughts and actions
- 3. Ask others to respond to various situations and events

# Lesson 1:

- Tell others what to do when there's a problem
- If there is a problem, ask what to do and give advice

# Lesson 2:

- Express feelings of disappointment
- Talk to others about disappointing events
- Express dissatisfaction when the result is not what you expected

# Lesson 3:

- Use correct verb and adjective forms according to grammatical expressions
- Summary of words that express opposite meanings

# Lesson 4:

- Explain an upcoming situation
- Describe your current situation
- Describe the situation immediately after it is over

# Lesson 5:

- Give reasons and excuses for not being able to do something, due to lack of experience
- Give your own thoughts and opinions, judging from objective reasons

# Lesson 6:

- Tell information obtained from news etc. to others
- Talk about what you have heard from others
- Talk about the current situation of a mutual friend or acquaintance

# Lesson 7:

- Observe a situation and tell people what you've determined
- Tell people what you inferred from five senses when you're walking down a street



#### Lesson 8:

- Learn how to make a causative form of verbs
- Use expressions that involve coercion
- Give permission to others and make them do something

# Lesson 9:

- Give opinions and advice when someone is depressed
- Ask people for permission to do what you want to do

# Lesson 10:

- Understand what honorific language is
- Use "respectful verbs" using the passive verbs you have learned.
- Use respective language "O-(verb-stem) ni narimasu"

# Lesson 11:

- "Special form" of honorific expressions can be understood and used
- Explain the actions of your seniors using honorific expressions
- Act based on polite instructions

# Lesson 12:

- Understand when to use "respectful" and "humble" expressions
- Use very polite expressions and offer help to someone

# Lesson 13:

- Introduce yourself in formal situations such as business scenes
- Have a conversation using honorific expressions in formal situations such as business scenes

# Lesson 14:

- Use different forms depending on the expression you want to convey
- Choose the form you want to use in a conversation based on the context
- Use adverbs and time expressions correctly

# Lesson 15:

- Incorporate expressions learned in Levels 5-8 into conversation
- Use a variety of forms in conversation and express what they want to say accurately



# Lesson 16:

- Make appropriate responses/actions to others according to the situation you're placed in
- Carry on conversations based on differences in positions and situations
